

COMPUTING

We will consolidate our coding skills by designing a text based adventure game using a given criteria using timers, scores, selection and variables. Then we will develop an understanding of appropriate online behaviour and how to keep ourselves and others safe online.

PSHE

We will begin by thinking about our goals for the year ahead before exploring who we are and how we fit into the world and our communities.

We will then celebrate our differences by discussing what is 'normal' and how we can promote celebration for others.

FRENCH

In this unit, we will learn the nouns and definite articles for 10 school subjects. We'll practice expressing likes and dislikes with reasons, and saying when subjects are studied.

We'll also develop skills to understand longer texts while exploring WW2.

MUSIC

This term we will learn about pitch, dynamics and tempo through the use of classical music. The focus piece for this unit will be Fingal's Cave by Mendelssohn.

We will explore popular songs from the time period of WW2 such as, 'Pack up your troubles in your old kit bag' and 'We'll meet again'. We will learn how to sing these songs with harmonies.

ENGLISH

We will start English by exploring narratives through a warning story about abandoned theme parks. During this unit we will continue to develop our dialogue writing skills to create our own warning story.

Next we will explore non-fiction through and explanation text about the Circulatory System before writing an explanation text of our own.

PE

We will begin to think more critically about performance and understand the importance of timing in gymnastics involving a wide range of equipment. We will also be revising out tag rugby skills by developing movement with the ball at speed, accurate passing on the move, effective timing of support runs, and applying attacking and defending tactics to win games.

YEAR 6 AUTUMN 1

MATHS

We will begin the Autumn Term by looking at the importance of the place value of numbers, before transferring our skill and knowledge into work around addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will then revise our knowledge of fractions.

ART

We will be revisiting prior learning about colour theory. We will learn about the use of colour in four art movements before using this knowledge to create a painting with personal meaning. Next we will learn about the concepts of abstraction and distortion. We'll study the visual characteristics of abstraction and create a musically-inspired, abstract painting.

GEOGRAPHY

This term we will revise our essential skills and knowledge of the features of Earth, time zones and lines of latitude and longitude to pinpoint places on a map. We will find out more about map scales, grid references, contour lines and map symbols. Then we will learn about climate change and the importance of global trade.

HISTORY

This term we focus on the topic of Britain at War. We look at the causes of the First and Second World War, along with the events that happened during both wars. We will also look at the events that led to the end of both wars and the consequences of the wars.

SCIENCE

This term will revise our learning about all the bodily systems before looking deeper into the transport role of the human circulatory system, its main parts and primary functions. We will explore about healthy lifestyle choices and the effects of harmful substances on the body.
